**The District will be administering the Keystone Exams beginning the week of May 14.** The exam schedule includes a three-hour delay for non-testing students on May 14 and 15 only. Bus transportation will be provided to all non-testing students on a three-hour delay on these days. Students participating in the Keystone Exams will report at the normal start time. Regular bus transportation will be provided to those students who are participating in the Keystone Exams. Students who attend Parkway who are not taking an exam should report to the high school and Parkway as usual. All students presently enrolled in Biology I or English 10 will be required to take the corresponding Keystone Exams. In addition, students who have previously taken the Algebra I, Biology or Literature Keystone Exam, but did not score proficient will be scheduled to retake the corresponding exam in May. Please contact the guidance office at extension 250 with any questions. The Keystone Exam schedule is as follows:

- Biology on May 14 - three-hour delay for non-testing students
- Literature on May 15 - three-hour delay for non-testing students
- Algebra Module #1 on May 16 - all students should report at 7:20 a.m.
- Algebra Module #2 on May 17- all students should report at 7:20 a.m.
